Where chess was concerned we emerged gloriously victorious with Jeyan Arthur Moses of class (VIII) and M. Lakshmanan of class (XI) coming first






We are proud that Blassy Mary George (XI) and Nithin Anujan (XI) were elected School Pupil Leader and Sports Captain respectively.



WHAT IS "GREENHOUSE" EFFECT?

This is a phenomenon whereby the surface of a planet is heated by trapping of infra red radiation by the atmosphere. This mechanism is important in the atmosphere of the Earth, Venus, and Titan. The dense atmosphere surrounding Venus consists of unbreakable carbon dioxide gas. This results in "greenhouse effect". The atmosphere lets in the sun's rays but does not let heat escape. So the surface temperature is 4750 C!

The increased burning of fossil fuel increases the amount of carbon-dioxide in the atmosphere. This is what some experts believe.

WHAT ARE CFC's?

Chloroflurocarbons are man made gases that are used in a number of household gadgets such as fridges, washing machines etc. In industrial process also they are put to various uses. CFC'S are released from these and in the process of utilising them for production of other materials.

When CFC's decay into chlorine gas, that gas can destroy ozone. Hence they are efficient ozone depleting chemicals. Much publicity has been given to make ozone-friendly materials and to phase out CFC's.

FACTS ABOUT HUMAN BODY

WHAT ARE PIMPLES?

Pimples start most often in the follicles of the hair. The sebaceous gland deposits an oily secretion there. When the follicles get blocked, it forms a blemish which we call as black heads. The cause of pimples is harden to explain than black heads. They may be due to many conditions, including improper diet, a glandular imbalance or tiny infections of the skin. The cause of acne varies from person to person. They include blackheads, pustules, cysts and nodules.

WHAT IS DANDRUFF?

It was once thought that dandruff was the manifestation of Seborrhoea. Seborrhoea is a condition where there is too much of secretion from sebaceous glands. It is now known that the scales that form on the scalp are from the horny layer of the skin and are not dried sebum. Scientists are still not sure as to the real cause of dandruff. Some sort of infection is indicated. But this is yet to be proved.

WHAT CAUSES CORNS?

Corn is a localised thickening of the skin, shaped like a pyramid, with the apex pointing inwards. Corns are produced chiefly by local pressure particularly on the feet as a result of badly-fitting shoes. They are best treated by experts - one who treats ailments of the feet.

HOW DO WE READ?

When you read, you look at certain symbols and are able to get some meaning from them. For example, a kind of "reading" is going on when you read symbols on a road sign, or when an engineer reads the markings on a blueprint, or when an Indian sees smoke signals! When we say "reading" we usually mean reading print or writing. But here, too, we must understand the symbols. The first thing we have to do in learning to read is to recognize the symbols or letters as being different from others. Then we must get the idea for which a word stands.



But before we can understand fully, we must be able to relate the symbols or word to our own experience.

Over the years, children have been taught to read by various methods. The "Spelling" method begins by teaching the child the names of the letters of the alphabet in order. Next he puts two letters together, then three letters, and then spells and pronounces syllables and then these are joined into words, phrases and sentences. In the "phonetic' methods children learn the sounds of the letters, then put the sounds together to make the words. At first only short words are made, then longer ones. In still another method, the child memorizes the way a words looks. Other methods use both sounding out and remembering the way a word, phrase, or sentence looks. But we can only learn to read when we are ready to begin learning. And for this we must be able to see words or symbols that are alike and different; remember the form a word; remember ideas in the order in which they are given, bring to mind pictures of objects that the words describe, move eyes from left to right on a page - and many more things.

WHAT HAPPENED TO DINOSAURS?

About 180 million years ago the reptiles ruled the earth. In fact, there was so many of them and they were so powerful, that this period is known as the Era of Reptiles. The scientific name for this period is Mesozoic Era.

The largest of all the reptiles were the dinosaurs. And the largest dinosaurs were probably the biggest animals that ever walked on earth!. Yet, about a million years ago the dinosaurs died out because changing conditions made life impossible for them. The first dinosaurs were probably no bigger than a turkey, and like a turkey, they walked on their hind legs. In time, some of them grew heavier and longer, and finally became so heavy that their legs would not support them on land. So they had to spend most of their lives in rivers and swamps, where water could keep their huge bodies afloat.

One of these giants was called "Brontosaurus". This dinosaur was 20 to 25 metres long and weighed about 38 tons. Other kinds of dinosaurs remained on land. For instance "the Tyrannosaurus" was a monster about 14 metres long and 6 metres high. The Tyrannosaurus was probably the most ferocious animal that ever lived. Dinosaurs developed in many different ways, but one of them ever developed a good brain. One reason dinosaurs disappeared may be that they were just not bright enough to know how to survive and escape from all their natural en-

emies. One of the biggest unsolved mysteries is why, 66 million years ago, the dinosaurs suddenly died out. Most scientists believe that changes in the earth and in climate killed the dinosaurs. Swamps dried up, mountains appeared and certain dinosaurs could not live on dry land. Also changes in climate produced changes in vegetation and since many dinosaurs were plant eaters, their food supply disappeared! And finally as the earth began to have seasons, shifting from hot summers to snowy winters, dinosaurs could not fit themselves to these changes and gradually died out.



KERALA - THE LAND OF PALACES

Do you know that Kerala has a name called "THE LAND OF PALACES?". Here are details about some palaces.

1) Sakthan Tampuram Palace - Thrissur:

Originally called Vadakkekara Palace, it was reconstructed in the Kerala - Dutch style in 1795 by Sri Rama Varma Thampuran of Cochin, well known as Sakthan Tampuran, for his stay.

2) Hill palace - Trippunithura:

The official residence of the Royal family of Cochin was built in 1865 on an extensive area of 52 acres of terraced land as a palace complex consisting of 49 buildings with traditional indigenous architectural interiors. Now it is converted into a heritage Museum of Kerala.

The northern most kingdom of Kerala, Neeleswaram palace has preserved the cultural heritage of North Malabar.



Tigris. The Siberian tiger (Amur) is classified as Panthera Tigris Alataica and the Indian tigers are classified as Panthera Tigris Tigris.





EARTHQUAKES

On 12th December 2000 majority of south Indian dwellers experienced earthquakes. Earth is a restless planet which trembles frequently but most of the movements are so slight that they are not felt. Others make big cracks or bring complete disaster on land. Earth's crust is moving all the time and this moving part is called "plates", When the plates slide fast or into each other the rocks jolt and sent out shock waves - the earth shakes and an earthquake occurs. Earthquakes happen in seas also. The place within the earth where an earthquake starts is the "epicentre" of the quake.

The study of earthquake and the allied happenings is called seismology. The Mercalli/Ritcher scales measure the intensity of shock and it is divided into 12 intensities based on the shock. We may not feel an earthquake at an intensity of 1 where as by intensity 12 there will be total destruction. Our seismologists confirm that the chances of earthquakes occuring in South India especially in Idukky District is high. The Ritcher Scale may measure 6.5 to 7.5 strength according to Dr. Sreevasthava - the Vice Chairman, Indian Meteorological Department. He repeated that there were fault lines - the cracks when an earthquake is taking place and calls it Periyar fault.

It is said that by way of research and studies an

eminent seismologists can forecast the chance of occurring earthquake. It is said that even the birds and animals specially dogs can perceive the unusual phenomena and they produce unusual sounds. One eminent scientist Dr. Rasthogi states that when an earthquake takes place, the level of water may increase in wells, especially in the bore wells. Sometimes it may even over flow.

If we are in indoors during an earthquake, it is said, we are better off being under heavy table or stand at the doorway or the corners of a room. When the quake is over go outside, away from buildings, to a wide open space.

CARROTS

The carrot, a popular vegetable, is a highly valuable food. It is very good for health when eaten raw. The skin should not be scrapped off but should be thoroughly cleaned, as its mineral contents are very close to the skin. The leaves of this vegetable which are usually discarded, are highly nourishing and health building.

The botanical name of the carrot is 'Daucus Carota'. It appears to have originated in central Asia, and in the hills of Punjab and Kashmir. It is a cool season crop.

The carrot consists of 86.0% of moisture, 0.9% Protein, 0.2% fat, 1.1% minerals, 1.2% fibre and 10.6% Carbohydrates per 100 gm of edible portion:

The carrot is an oxidant and powerful cleansing food. It is rich in alkaline elements which purify and revitalise the blood. It fights cancer, protects arteries, boosts the immune system and combats infections. The juice of carrot is known as 'miracle juice'. It strengthens eyes, and keeps the mucous membranes of all cavities of the body in healthy condition.

Raw carrots are highly beneficial in the treatment of high blood cholestrol. According to Dr. Philip Pfeffer and Dr. Peter Hoagland, scientists at the US department of Agriculture's eastern Regional Research Centre, they are rich in anticholestrol


soluble fibre including pentin.

The use of raw carrots helps to keep the teeth and gums in healthy condition. Chewing a raw carrot immediately after a meal kills all the harmful germs in the mouth. It also cleans the teeth, removes the food particles lodged in the crevices and prevents bleeding of the gums and tooth decay.

Chewing a raw carrot increases saliva production and quickens digestion by supplying the necessary enzymes, minerals and vitamins. It also prevents the formation of gastric ulcer and other digestic disorders.

Raw carrot juice is a natural solvent for ulcerous and cancerous conditions. It help to prevent infections of eyes, throat, tonsils and sinuses as well as of the respiratory organs in general.

MY TRIP TO CHENNAI




TOM AND JERRY:

Day : Monday
Date : 11-2-2K
Time : 6:54:21

Measurement: 5 in the richter scale
Epicenter: Pynavu (Iddukki dist)

I woke up around 6:45 in the morning and I lay awake in my bed. Around 6:55 my beds started shaking mildly: I lasted for about 2 seconds. I though that it was my father shaking the bed to wake me up. I had no idea that it was an earthquake. My mother, who was in the kitchen, felt the vessels kept in the meat safe shaking. My father too felt the tremor. The uncle next door came running and asked us whether we had felt anything 'like a earthquake' We said 'yes'.

Our doubts were clarified when we heard the morning news in the TV. It said that a mild tremor was experienced in Idukki and neighbouring districts. The earthquake measured 5 in the Richter scale and its epicentre was at Pynavu. I will never forget this experience.

What is an Earthquake and how is it caused? An earthquake is a sudden vibration caused on the earth's surface.

The outer rocky shell of the earth, which is

known as lithosphere is broken into a mosaic of six rigid spherical caps known as Plates. The bound aries between these plates form active belts of earth quakes and volcanoes. Along some boundaries, the plates push against each other raising mountains and thus form an earthquake. An earthquake may also be caused due to a volcanic eruption and also due to the folding and faulting of rocks.

Some important terminology:

EPICENTRE: The place vertically

above focus is known as the epicentre. As you go away from the epicentre, its effect becomes lesser

and lesser.

RICHTER SCALE: The earthquake is mea-

sured in a richter scale.

SEISMOGRAPH: It is an instrument which

records the strength and measurement of earth-

quakes.

SEISMOLOGY: The study of earthquakes.






मेरा प्रिय खेल

इस ग्रन्थ में सुश्रुत के प्रयासों व अभूतपूर्व प्रयोगों पर आधारित सुश्रुत शल्य तंत्र ही प्रथम प्रमाणिक ग्रन्थ है। इस ग्रन्थ की रचना ईसा पूर्व छठी शाताब्दी में हुई। तब से लगभग दो सौ वर्ष बाद नागार्जुन ने इस ग्रन्थ को एक नया रूप प्रदान किया।

इस ग्रन्थ का लेखन प्रशनोत्तर रूप में किया गया है। प्रश्न सुश्रुत द्वारा किए गए है तथा धन्वतिर ने उन्हें उपदेश दिया है। कुछ विद्वानों का मत है कि हमारे देश में शल्य चिकित्सा करनेवाले लोगों को धन्वतिर कहा जाता था परन्तु महिता से ज्ञात होता है कि धन्वंतिर काशीराज थे। संहिता के आरंभ के अध्यायों में शाल्य चिकित्सा का ही वर्णन है। सुश्रुत न केवल शल्य चिकित्सक थे वे जीव विज्ञान तथा वनस्पति शास्त्र के ज्ञाता भी थे। सुश्रुत ने लिखा है कि विद्यार्थी को पहल छेद्य तथा भेद्य कर्म सीखने चाहिए तभी वह बैद्य कर्म में सफल हो सकता है। सुश्रुत अपने विद्यार्थियों को शव छेदन की शिक्षा भी देते थे। सुश्रुत ने अपने ग्रन्थ में लगभग सौ शल्य चिकित्सा थंत्रों का वर्णन किया है। तत्कालीन चिकित्सा थंत्र यथापि आधुनिक थंत्रों की भाँति नहीं होगे तथापि उनका उपने युग में विशेष महत्व था। वे अधिकांश पशुओं व पक्षियों के मुखाकार के आधार पर निर्मित किए गए। जैसे शेर, चीता, कौआ, गिद्ध, चील आदि।

सन् आठ सौ में सुश्रुत सहिता का अनुवाद अरबी भाषा में टिकताब ए सुश्रुतट के नाम से हुआ। अरब के प्रसिद्ध चिकित्सक टिठिजिसट ने अपनी पुस्तकों में सुश्रुत का उल्लेख किया तथा उसे शल्य विज्ञान का आचार्य माना।

नवी, दसवीं शाताब्दी तक सुश्रुत संहिता ने पर्याप्त ख्याति प्राप्त कर ली थी। भारतीय शल्य चिकित्सा के इतिहास में सुश्रुत का नाम सदैव याद किया जाता रहेगा।

१८९१ में ये बैरस्टर बनकर स्वदेश लौटे तो इन्होंने अहमदाबाद में वकालत प्रारम्भ की। स्वदेश लौटने के बाद उने यहा भी एसी ही स्थिति मिली। गाँधिजी ने यहाँ भी गोरी सरकार के विरुद्ध अहिंसा सत्याग्रह और असहयोग का संग्राम छेड दिया।

३० जनवरी १९४८ को नायुराम गौडसें ने बिडला भवन नई दिल्ली में गोली चलाकर इनकी लौकिक लाला समाप्त कर दीं।

वे जब तब जियें वीरता से जिये और मरें भी वीरों के समान ही। उनकी यह उन्नित सदा अमर रहेगी - मेरा यह पूर्ण विश्वास हे कि प्रथ्वि प्रेम के बल पर ही पल रही है। वास्तव में जीवन वहीं है जहाँ प्रेम है।

भारत रत्न इंदिरा गाँधी

श्रीमती इंदिरा गाँधी स्वतंत्र भारत के प्रथम प्रधान मंत्री, इतिहास-पूरुष, यूग पूरुष, भारत रत्न जवहरलाल नेररु की पूत्री थी। इनका जन्म १९ नवंबर १९१५ को इलाहाबाद में हुआ। माता कमला नेहरु थी। पितामह मोतीलालजी नेहरु ने इनका नाम इंदिरा प्रियदर्शिनी रखा था। इनकी प्रारंभिक शिक्षा इलाहाबाद में हुई। इसके बाद शांतिनिकेतन में श्री रवीन्द्रनाथ ठाकूर के संरक्षण में शिक्षा पाई और उनके दार्शनिक विचारो से प्रभावित हुई। इन्होंने लदंन में भी शिक्षा पाई।

सन् १९४२ में उसका विवाह फीरोज गाँधी के साथ हुआ। तब से ये इंदिरा गाँधी कहलाई। सन् १९६० में इनका पित का देहांत हो गया।

१८ जनवरी १९६६ को ये प्रथम बार भारत की प्रधान मंत्री बनीं। चौथे आम चूनाव में काग्रस की ज़ीत होने पर ये फिर भारत की प्रधान मंत्री बनी। सन् १९८१ में बंगलादेश की आज़ादी के लिए भारत और पाकिस्तान में भयंकर लडाई हूई तब पाकिस्तान की करारी हार हूई। तब इंदिरा गाँधी टदुर्गा का अवतारठ मानी गई। उनकी कर्तव्य निष्ठा और उत्साह को देखकर उस समय के

राष्ट्रपति श्री. वि.वि. गिरि ने उनको 'भारतरत्न' की उपाधि दी।

जब इंदिरा गाँधी प्रधान मंत्री बनीं तब देश में सांप्रदायिकता, क्षेत्रवाद, जातिवाद आदि समाज को तोड़ रहे थे। वे एकता बनाये रखना चाहती थी। अपनी प्रधान मंत्रित्व के काल में इंदिराजी ने कठिन से कठिन परिस्थितियों और धैर्य नही छोडा। आत्म-विश्वास निर्णय-क्षमता तथा दुरदिशता, उनके स्वाभाव के अभिन्न अंग थे। उनके जीवन में हार केलिए जगह ही न थी।

भारत का सौभाग्य है कि उसे इंदिरा जैसी कर्मठ, प्रगितशील और गरीबों के दुख-दर्द को समझनेवाली प्रधान मंत्री मिली। महान काम सब को नहीं कर सकते हैं। महान कामों से ही कोई भी महान बनाता है। इस दृष्टि से इंदिराजी भारत की सबसे बडी नेत्री मानी जायेंगी। साथ ही यह भी साबित कर दिया कि -

नारी त्रैलोक्य जननी नारी त्रैलोक्य रुपिणी। नारी त्रभुवनाधारा नारी देह क्वरूपिणी।

देहावसान के बाद रानी पर विपत्तियों का पहाड़ टूट पड़ा। अंग्रेज़ों ने भारत में आई और रियासत झाँसी को अपने राज्य में सम्मिलित कर लिया। अंग्रेज़ों की नीति से असन्तुष्ट होकर १८५७ में सैनिकों ने अंग्रेज़ी शासन के विरुद्ध विद्रोंह कर दिया। अंग्रेज़ों ने झाँसी पर आक्रमण कर दिया। झाँसी की सेना और अंग्रेज़ों के बीच एक युद्ध हो गया। उस युद्ध में लक्ष्मीबाई की सेना बहुत पराक्रमी थी। उस युद्ध में लक्ष्मीबाई का अंत हुई। हमारे स्वतंन्त्रता के लिए उसने अपने जीवन बलिदान कर दिया।




पुस्तकें और उनका महत्व

पुस्तकों में लाभ ते असंख्या होते है, परन्तु यदि पुस्तकों के विषय अच्छे नहीं है। तो उनसे हानि भी हो जाती है। जिस प्रकार से सहवास और मित्रता का अच्छा बुरा दोनों प्रकार का प्रभाव पडता है। उसी प्रकार पुस्तकों का भी अच्छा और बुरा दोनों प्रकार का प्रभाव पडता है। विनाशकारी अश्त्र-शस्त्रों का आविष्कार भी तो पुस्तकों की सहायता से होरहा है। जिससे मानव-जाति का अस्तित्व ही खतरे में पड गया है। इसी प्रकार और भी अनेक हानियाँ हो सकती है।

आज के युग में पुस्तकों का महत्व अधिक बढ गया है। विद्यार्थियों को पाठ पुस्तकों द्वारा पढाया जाता है।

पाकशास्त्र से लेकर धर्म-शास्त्र तक तथा अर्थ-शास्त्र से लेकर दर्शन शास्त्र तक की असंख्या पुस्तकें है। जिनका अपना-अपना महत्व है। उनसे पाठक अपनी रुचि के अनुसार लाभ उठा सकता है।

हमारी राजधानी दिल्ली




